



SUWARROW NATIONAL PARK RULES

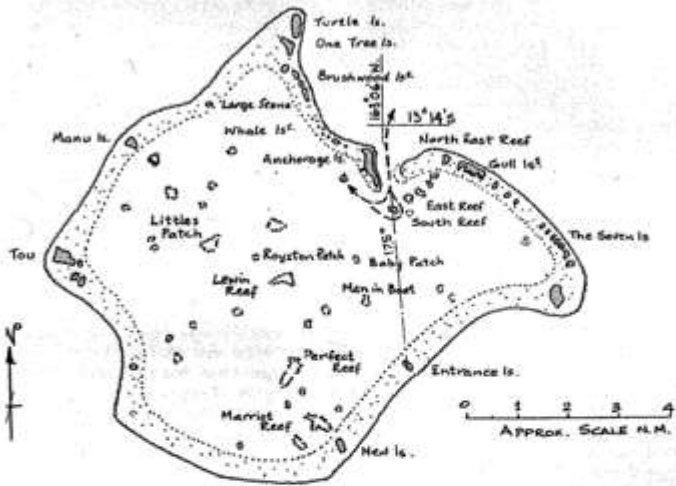
Entry

1. No entry to the Suvarrow National Park before 1st June or after the 1st November each year.
2. Access to Suvarrow National Park is permitted upon payment of an entrance fee of US\$50 per vessel, subject to:
 - a maximum of 7 persons per vessel staying no more than 2 weeks;
 - a payment of US\$5 per person per fortnight for any additional person on the vessel;
 - no fee for children under 15 years of age.

Prohibitions

3. No taking of :-
 - (a) shells or flesh from shells;
 - (b) any birds or eggs, or part of any bird or egg, or taking of or tampering with any nest;
 - (c) female lobster with eggs attached;
 - (d) female coconut crab with eggs attached;
 - (e) any live fish for aquariums;
 - (f) any Puka shell from the lagoon;
 - (g) any whale bone or whale tooth from the islands.
4. No use of spear guns within the lagoon.
5. No entry into bird or turtle nesting areas.
6. No harassing, disturbing, harming or killing of any marine mammals.
7. No littering.
8. No discharging or dumping of :-
 - (a) waste on the islands, sandbanks, or in the lagoon;
 - (b) any poison, paint, oil, batteries, or other pollutants from any vessel inside the lagoon.
