REPORT ON PIRACY INCIDENT AGAINST S/Y MARITIMA ON SUNDAY 27TH DECEMBER.

11.20am, TUESDAY 29TH DECEMBER, 2016:

I just got a call on the telephone from Mr. Jonas Rommel in Grenada. Mr. Rommel is the captain and owner of the S/Y Maritima, a 32 foot white sailing yacht. Mr. Rommel reports:

HE LEFT TRINIDAD AT ABOUT 5AM ON SUNDAY 27TH DECEMBER SAILING TO GRENADA WITH HIS TWO SONS ABOARD HIS BOAT, MARITIMA.

AT ABOUT 10AM, WHEN THEY WERE ABOUT 30 N.MLS FROM TRINIDAD TO THE NORTH AND A LITTLE TO THE WEST OF THE OIL RIG HE WAS APPROACHED FROM THE EASTERN SIDE BY A PIROGUE.

THE PIROGUE WAS WHITE (OR SLIGHTLY BLUISH) ON THE OUTSIDE WITH A GREY GUNNEL. THE PEOPLE IN THE PIROGUE HELD HIM UP WITH WHAT APPEARED TO BE A RIFLE BUT HE COULD NOT SAY FOR SURE AS IT WAS HIDDEN BY A PIECE OF CLOTH.

THERE WERE SIX PERSONS ABOARD THE PIROGUE. ALL WERE VENEZUELAN. ALL WERE BETWEEN 20 TO 30 YEARS OLD AND ALL WERE TYPICAL VENEZUELAN, OFF-WHITE IN COMPLEXION.

THE PIROGUE HAD A 130 HP OUTBOARD ON ITS TRANSOM AND A 150 HP OUTBOARD LYING ON THE FLOOR INSIDE THE BOAT.

THE PIROGUE HAD THREE BLUE BARRELS IN IT, PRESUMABLY CONTAINING EXTRA FUEL.

3 OF THE VENEZUELANS CAME ABOARD MARITIMA AND THEY TOOK EVERYTHING THEY
COULD GET: CLOTHES, COMPUTER, CELL PHONES, TRINIDAD FLAG, CLOCK, ETC. TOTAL VALUE
ABOUT \$4,000US

THE VENEZUELANS THREATENED TO KILL MR. ROMMEL IF HE CALLED FOR HELP. THE VENEZUELANS WERE ABOARD FOR ABOUT 20 MINUTES.

AFTER THE ROBBERY THE PIROGUE HEADED OFF IN A S.W. DIRECTION, TOWARDS VENEZUELA.
